<b>German</b>	<b>Sounds like:</b>	<b>Example pronunciation</b>
w	v	<i>was</i> sounds like 'vas'
ß	ss	<i>Fußball</i> sounds like 'Fussball'
z	ts	<i>zehn</i> sounds like 'ts-ehn'
v	f	<i>vier</i> sounds like 'fear'
j	y	<i>ja</i> sounds like 'ya'
ch	...	<i>ich, Milch, Österreich</i>
'd' at the end of a word	t	<i>und</i> sounds like 'unt'
ei	i (eye)	<i>drei</i> sounds like 'dry'
ie	e (eee)	<i>sieben</i> sounds like 'seeeben'
ö	oe	<i>Köln</i> sounds like 'Koeln'
ä	ae	<i>Sänger</i> sounds like 'Saenger'
ü	ue	<i>München</i> sounds like 'Muenchen'
St	shh-t	<i>Stadt</i> sounds like 'Shh-t-adt'
Sp	shh-p	<i>Sport</i> sounds like 'Shh-p-ort'
